

Salisbury Planning Commission
Minutes of the December 6, 2021 Meeting – DRAFT

Members present: Ariell Slater, Morgan Cate, Barrie Bailey, Deb Brighton
Also: Katie Raycroft-Meyer, ACRPC

Ariell opened the meeting at 7:06 to discuss the Natural Resource Goals and Objectives. Katie drafted some new language about flood resilience that would keep the town eligible for Emergency Relief and Assistance Fund. She also recommended that the town consider adopting River Corridor Protection Regulations. Members expressed interest in following up, and Katie will send a link to a webinar that she felt would be helpful.

Most of the meeting was dedicated to drawing lines on the map to delineate the village district. It was agreed to merge what are now two lake districts into one district. The main reason for having two lake districts in the old plan was to highlight the unique importance of shoreland protection. However, since the state now has a Shoreland Protection Act that serves that purpose, there is no need for two Lake districts.

Katie agreed to draft descriptions of the new land use regions, for discussion during the January meeting. She will also look over the Land Use Goals and Objectives as revised by the Commission at the November meeting.

The minutes of the November 8 meeting were passed unanimously.

The next meeting will be Monday, January 10.
