

Salisbury Planning Commission
Minutes of the January 10, 2022 Meeting – DRAFT

Members present: Ariell Slater, Morgan Cate, Barrie Bailey, Deb Brighton reprise

Ariell opened the meeting at 7:05.

Members reviewed the Goals and Objectives and added an objective to maintain/renovate old historic structures in the rural region. There were also a few wording changes. The updates will be added to the Google Doc for review.

The descriptions of the land use regions generated more discussion. In the end, members reiterated an earlier decision not to designate a commercial/industrial area and to support only small scale and home-based businesses. No substantive changes were made, but wording changes will be added to the Google Doc for review.

Barrie suggested the plan should call for a charging station for electric cars in the Lakes Region, where it would be particularly useful to the summer tourists. It was decided that this recommendation should be part of the implementation of the energy section of the plan.

The commission then reviewed the options for the boundaries of the village region. The group preferred Option C with the addition of the area between the south side of Rogers Road and the Leicester line. This option does not include any land on the west side of Route 7.

The minutes of the January 10 meeting were accepted as submitted.

The next meeting will be March 7.
