

Salisbury Planning Commission
Minutes of the June 6, 2022 Meeting – DRAFT

Members present: Ariell Slater, Barrie Bailey, Deb Brighton
Also present: Katie Raycroft-Meyer, ACRPC

Ariell opened the meeting at 7:00. The purpose of the meeting was to review the draft of the plan which has been submitted to the state Agency . Ariell asked Katie to point out the sections that she felt the commission should discuss. Katie pointed to the sections on economy, transportation, utilities, and town facilities.

During the meeting, Katie realized that the document we were reviewing did not reflect all the changes she had made in the text, so the review process was paused until she can send a revised edition. The commission also pointed out changes needed in several charts which the ACRPC will make.

Barrie asked for the area of old growth forest to be shown on the map of significant natural resources. She also pointed out that trails and areas open to the public but not in public ownership should be included in the discussion of town facilities. These would include the conservation easement on the property on Upper Plains Road, the MALT Salisbury Mills parcel, and the Farwell forest.

The minutes of the May 2 meeting were approved by consensus.

The only correspondence was the permit report, which indicated applications for major subdivisions on Dewey Road and Upper Plains Road.

The next meeting will be Monday, July 11. Before that date, a revised version of the draft plan will circulate for comments via Google Docs.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05.
