Minutes of the November 28, 2022 Meeting – DRAFT

Members present: Ariell Slater, Barrie Bailey, Deb Brighton

Ariell called the meeting to order at 7:05.

Members discussed updating the zoning regulations and decided to review the current regulations and then to devote most of the next meeting to outlining the areas that need to be changed, and developing questions to discuss with the DRB. After that, the commission would meet with the DRB to gain the insights of the people trying to apply the current regulations.

Discussion turned to the possibility of creating a trail between the village and the lake. Green Mountain power has given the commission permission to walk on their land. A GMP representative said the company would “entertain” a proposal. Members decided to do a preliminary reconnaissance of the upper portion of the area on Sunday, December 4 at 1:00.

The only correspondence was the zoning report.

The next meeting will be Monday, January 9. The homework assignment is to review the current zoning regulations and note areas that should be changed.
