

Salisbury Planning Commission  
Minutes of the October 24 Hearing and Meeting – DRAFT

Members present: Ariell Slater, Morgan Cate, Deb Brighton, Barrie Bailey

The public hearing on the proposed Town Plan, which was advertised to begin at 7 pm, did not attract any comments from the public.

At 7:10, Ariell called the planning commission meeting to order. Morgan made a motion to send the draft plan to the select board without any additional changes. The motion was seconded by Barrie and approved unanimously.

Members turned from the town plan to the next steps. Although revising the unified regulations is important, the timing does not work out for this round of grant applications for zoning modernization. The commission will watch for the next opening. A more immediate opportunity is to work on connecting the village to the Lake (and beyond) by a trail. Members agreed to pursue this by talking with Green Mountain Power, researching grant opportunities, and devoting time at the November meeting to developing a proposal.

Correspondence included notices of workshops, notice of a residential development application in Middlebury, and reports from the zoning administrator.

After a discussion of ways to entice more people to participate in local government, the meeting was adjourned at 8:05.
